

Take Flight with Poetry

WHAT'S NEEDED

Westcott Hot Glue Gun and Glue Sticks
Westcott Ergo Jr. 5" Kids Scissors
4 1/2" x 5" white paper
6" x 7" construction paper rectangle
7" x 8" different-color construction paper rectangle
8" x 9" different-color construction paper rectangle
Black construction paper scrap

STEPS



STEP ONE

Fold the 6" x 7" construction paper rectangle in half vertically. Cut out a butterfly shape.




STEP TWO

Fold the remaining construction paper rectangles in half. Using the first butterfly cutout as a guide, cut the 7" x 8" rectangle so it is slightly larger than the cutout; then use the second cutout to cut the 8" x 9" rectangle so it is slightly larger than the second cutout.



STEP THREE

Stack the three cutouts from smallest to largest and glue them together at the center. Make antennae from the black construction paper scrap and glue them in place.



STEP FOUR

Copy your butterfly poem on the white paper. Glue your poem to the center of the 3-D butterfly.
